LOCATION	<p>Bloomington Fine Arts Center 1800 W. Old Shakopee Road</p> <p>The Arts Center is at the corner of Logan and 98th Street. Come in the Arts Center doors at the Northwest end of the building, by the large wooden pillars.</p> <p>This event is very crowded and it is difficult to find a parking space. It is often easier for parents to pull up to the Arts Center doors and drop-off their singers.
